### <u>Submission to FADT References Committee Inquiry on the capability of</u> Defence's physical science and engineering (PSE) workforce

My name is Edmond Christensen and I am an APS Level 5 employed as a Maintenance Manager within 453SQN and work at the RAAF Richmond Base in New South Wales.

I am pleased to write a submission for the Senate Inquiry into the capability of Defence's physical science and engineering (PSE) workforce with particular reference to Term:

### (g) the ability to attract and retain a highly-skilled PSE workforce in Defence, DMO and DSTO.

I have worked in the industry for 41 years (RAN - 27 Years / APS - 14 Years), my time in the RAN culminated in my discharge in July 2001 as a Petty Officer Aircraft Technician Avionics (POATV) from 2001 – June 2003 I served as a Technical Officer, APS Level in ALSPO, then from July 2003 till present I have served as the Maintenance Manager Tower (MMTWR) 453SQN RIC FLT. I have over 12 years experience as the MMTWR and I am trained on all electronic equipment maintained and used by 453SQN RIC FLT.

#### **Department of Defence Technical Pay Comparison APS vs ADF**

The state of payment to APS technical staff within the Department of Defence (DoD) has fallen so far behind their military counterparts that staying in the APS DoD is fast becoming an extremely poor choice of employment.

The fact that our given employer has decided to grant one part of their workforce a backdated pay rise with no loss of conditions or requirement to, in any way, fund this pay rise is one such instance.

I use the term "our given employer" because the same organisation "Australian Defence Organisation" and the same signature "appear on both ADF and APS group certificates, therefore ADF and APS personnel are employed and paid by the same organisation. This same organisation then refuse to negotiate, or delay, the pay case for the rest of their employees with quite categorical statements of "No Back Pay" and if you can't fund the pay rise out of your hard fought for, fair and just conditions, then you will get nothing.

ADF personnel are promised that their pay rise will be re-visited and more given if the APS manage to be given a greater pay rise. Is this a clear cut case of workplace discrimination purely because I do not wear a uniform?

As mentioned above, I am an APS Level 5 employed as a Maintenance Manager within 453SQN. My annual reporting and accountable KERs clearly state I am a Manager of an operational airfield despite APS Work Level Standards limiting APS Level 5s "Management responsibilities to a very low level of difficulty". All staff managed by me are RAAF CETECHs, therefore I am a CETECH Manager, to compare my level of pay to that of

ADF personnel employed doing exactly the same technical and management work as me I referred to the Directorate of Military Remuneration – How to work out your pay grade and ADF Pay Rates page (see Attachments 1 and 2).

Communications Electronic Technical Manager (Column 19) is listed under Pay Grade 7. A CETECH Manager is of the rank of FSGT (see Attachment 3). APS Level 5 personnel have been granted Officers Mess privileges (we are considered equivalent officer level). All pay levels referenced here are from the ADF Pay Rates page and do not include any military specific allowances (please see Attachment 2).

A senior Corporal who I am expected to manage has a base pay of \$73,595: I receive a base pay of \$74,331; as you can see for all my added experience, training and management responsibilities I receive a grand total of \$736 a year more than my staff. (see Attachment 2 for ADF pay rates.)

A FSGTs base pay depending on experience varies from \$88,574 to \$90,003; a junior officer's base pay varies between a PLTOFF \$90,908 to FLGOFF \$98433. I have over 12 years experience doing CETECH Management, and get paid between \$14,243 to \$24,102 less than my ADF counterparts doing exactly the same work.

Thank you for allowing me to make a submission to this important Inquiry.
