Public hearing on Counter-Terrorism Bill

Parliament's Intelligence and Security committee will hold a public hearing in Canberra on Monday for its inquiry into the Counter-Terrorism Legislation Amendment Bill (No. 1) 2015.

The Bill is the sixth piece of national security legislation to be examined by the Committee during the current Parliament and proposes a range of amendments to existing counter-terrorism legislation, primarily relating to control orders. These include:

- allowing a control order to be imposed on persons 14 years and older, with additional safeguards;
- new powers for police to monitor compliance by individuals with control orders;
- providing greater protection to sensitive information in control order proceedings;
- amending the test for obtaining a preventative detention order; and
- creating a new criminal offence of 'advocating genocide'.
