The residents of the Gunnedah Basin that includes the towns of Quirindi, Gunnedah, Boggabri, Narrabri, Wee Waa and Moree are pushing to develop a Health Impact Assessment (HIA) for the region prior to

the commencement of large coal and gas developments.

To this end a Scoping Committee of 20 concerned citizens prepared a Terms of Reference (ToR) for the HIA in conjunction with the University of NSW Centre for Health Equity Training, Research and

Evaluation (CHETRE).

The ToR has been developed into a proposal and this proposal is the basis for our submission.

The HIA is focused on Physical, Mental, Social and Environmental Health. In order to satisfy establish existing environmental health the community is pushing for air quality baseline and water quality

baseline measures before large scale development.

It is our communities view that the air quality baseline are a vital part of the environmental health on

which the other aspects of health rely.

Our proposal is being progressed in government circles now and we are working to ensure that work on the HIA is complete within 18 month of the HIA's funding commitments. It is important that this timeline

is met before possible large scale mining and gas developments occur.
