THE SENATE INQUIRY INTO FORESTRY, MINING AND ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY ON THE TIWI ISLANDS

The Tiwi Bombers Football Club is writing this letter of support for the Tiwi Forestry Project which assists us in our aim to provide employment for our Tiwi players and to further enhance Leadership, Participation, Community Development and Capacity Building within our club and the Tiwi Islands community in general.

The Tiwi Bombers Football Club has developed a relationship with the Tiwi Forestry Project which is managed by Great Southern Limited in partnership with the Tiwi.

Great Southern have been financial sponsors of the Tiwi Bombers since our inception into the NTFL and this will continue into the future.

But the major benefit that we are developing with the Tiwi Forestry Project is through the Training and Employment of our players in the Tiwi Forestry Industry.
