Public hearing on HMAS Moreton project

The Parliamentary Standing Committee on Public Works will be holding public hearings in Brisbane on 28 July to examine the HMAS *Moreton* Unit Relocation Project.

The Department of Defence proposes to demolish some existing structures and construct a range of new facilities at HMAS *Moreton*, a Royal Australian Navy base in the Brisbane suburb of Bulimba. The Committee will be hearing from representatives of the local community to examine the local impact of the proposed construction, as well as the Department of Defence.

The estimated cost of the project is \$15.6 million, excluding GST.
