Following its public hearing in Brisbane on Wednesday, the [Parliamentary Innovations Committee](#) is in Sydney on Thursday to hold a public hearing [into its driverless vehicles inquiry](#).

Witnesses at the hearing will include Volvo Australia, the Insurance Australia Group, Telstra and the New South Wales Government.

“The diversity of witnesses at the Committee’s recent hearings demonstrates the wide range of social issues that will arise with the advent of driverless vehicles”, the Committee Chair, [Michelle Landry MP](#), said. “With such a multi-faceted topic, the Committee has been interested to hear so many different perspectives”.

The Committee has recently travelled to Perth, Melbourne and Brisbane for hearings and inspections, and will hold further hearings with key stakeholders in Canberra later in May and in June.
