**Clarification to Hansard — Fair Work Amendment (Paid Family and Domestic Violence Leave)
Bill 2022 — 22 August 2022**

I am writing to provide clarification to evidence I gave to the Education and Employment Legislation Committee hearing of 22 August 2022.

On page 64 of the transcript, in response to a question from Senator O’Sullivan on what was considered in Professor Duncan’s costings presented to the Fair Work Commission, I said:

“That’s true. Professor Duncan’s estimate is on the commission’s proposal, which does not extend to casuals but extends to full-time and part-time employees, who are the majority of the workforce.”

I wish to clarify that Professor Duncan estimated the cost of the Australian Council of Trade Unions proposal being granted in full, so casual employees are included in those estimates.
