We welcome the opportunity to provide a submission to the Senate Standing Committee on Environment, Communications and the Arts on the Telecommunications Legislation Amendment (Competition and Consumer Safeguards) Bill 2009.

iiNet Limited welcomes the Government's historic legislative reform of the Australian telecommunications industry with the introduction of the Telecommunications Legislation Amendment (Competition and Consumer Safeguards) Bill 2009.
