Senator SMITH: What is the state and territory contribution of the \$1.6 million or \$1.7 million?

Mr Ballis: Are we saying the Northern Territory?

Senator SMITH: No, the states and territories—what is the total? If you have the individual amounts that they have allocated, that would be handy.

Mr Ballis: Okay. I can certainly—

CHAIR: If you have not got that, you can take it on notice.

Mr Ballis: I do not have that information at hand, but I will be happy to provide the Senate with that information.

RecLink Response

Unfortunately I did not have the budget figures for Reclink for the period 13/14 during the Senate Select Committee hearing and it was not possible for me to accurately respond to Senator Smith's question.

The combined funding received by Reclink Australia for the 2013/14 financial year from Local, State, Territory and Federal Governments was \$1,324,535 (Ex GST) [See table below].

Other sources of funding accounted for \$940,504 in 2013/14. Total funding received by Reclink Australia for the period 2013/14 was \$2,265,039 [\$2,427,979 Including GST].

Funds allocated by Local, State, Territory and Federal Governments are delivered in accordance with grant/funding guidelines.
