

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ECONOMICS COMMITTEE Inquiry into Local Government Funding Issued: 4 December 2002

Inquiry into local government funding & responsibilities - Roundtable discussion with local Victorian councils in Warrnambool after Reserve Bank hearing this Friday -

The House of Representatives Economics Committee is examining the financial position of local government in Australia, and in particular the issue of cost-shifting onto local government.

The inquiry has been initiated in response to concerns that local government is increasingly having to provide a range of services to communities, such as health centres, aged care facilities, employment programs and security guards, without being provided financial resources to do so.

As part of the inquiry, the Committee will hold a roundtable discussion with local councils from southwestern Victoria, in **Warrnambool** on **Friday**, **6 December**. The roundtable will follow the Committee's public hearing with the Reserve Bank.

The inquiry is examining local government's current roles and responsibilities, current and alternative funding arrangements, and the scope for achieving a rationalisation of roles and responsibilities between the levels of government. It is interested in achieving better use of resources and delivering better quality services to local communities.
