Victorian Government to offer views on teacher education

The Victorian Department of Education will appear before the House of Representatives Education & Vocational Training Committee in Canberra tomorrow as the Committee's program of extensive public consultation draws to a close.

"Early last year, the Victorian Parliamentary Committee on Education & Training released a report into pre-service teacher training. The Victorian Government has responded to this report and therefore their appearance before the Committee has been keenly anticipated," said Committee Chair Luke Hartsuyker.

"The Victorian report made some very important recommendations on, among other things: the teaching practicum, the role of information technology and the mentoring of pre-service teachers. As each of these is critical to our inquiry, we eagerly await the opportunity to hear from our Victorian colleagues."

The Victorian Department of Education's submission is one of over 160 submissions the Committee has received from across Australia. The Committee held public hearings in the ACT, Victoria, Queensland, South Australia, the Northern Territory, Western Australia and Tasmania during 2005. The Committee has also held a number of hearings in the ACT and New South Wales in early 2006.
