RE: Reported Crime Statistics Compared to Court Prosecutions and Sentencing

For some time Gosford Chamber of Commerce has been concerned with the above, both on the Central Coast and throughout Australia.

We have gathered below statistics and consulted with various authorities to compile this report, which we hope will create action by the relative authorities and media who receive it.

Attached sheets A1 & A2 show the number of crimes reported in Gosford LGA in the Year 2000. Year 2001 has not been used because Court statistics are not available as yet.

Sheets A3, A4 & A5 show Court statistics by charge and penalty from Criminal Court, Higher Courts and Juvenile Justice Courts for Gosford LGA.

Sheet A6 Compilation of statistics.

Assessment From Above Statistics

ASSULTS: Only 368 offenders were apprehended and went to court out of 797 offenders. i.e. 46%. Around 21% of these appeared to get a "Reasonably Severe Penalty" to deter them and others.

ROBBERY: Only 10 offenders were apprehended and went to Court out of 59 offenders. i.e. 17%. Around 20% of these appeared to get a "Reasonably Severe Penalty".

UNLAWFUL ENTRY WITH INTENT/BURGULARY, BREAK & ENTER: Only 137 offenders were apprehended and went to court out of 3048 offenders. i.e. 5%. Around 42% of these appeared to get a "Reasonably Severe Penalty".
