Dear Mr Dreyfus

Re: Supplementary submission to the Inquiry into the Draft Disability Standards for Access to Premises.

Further to my submission dated 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2009 I would like to add the following issue/s:

- 1. The reduction to the continuous accessible path of travel (CAPT) from 1200mm to 1000mm minimum
- This is a loss of circulation space that will impact negatively upon people's ease of mobility and movement within the built environment and should be reconsidered
- However the inclusion of the CAPT requirements (in corridors) without chamfered corners being 1500mm is useful
- 2. Passing spaces for 2 people using wheelchairs shall be a minimum width of 1800mm for a minimum length of 2000mm at no more than 20m intervals
- This could result in some buildings with corridors up to 19M without an opportunity for 2 people using mobility devices to pass. Having worked in buildings without passing space I know this lack of circulation space results in people having to jump into doorways, users of wheelchairs having to wait at one end of a corridor until the other user has travelled through, and damage to walls, furniture and doors.
- 3. Lifts in new buildings with more than one level should be considered a mandatory requirement
- Any new building (with more than one level) constructed after this Disability Standard is passed should have a requirement for a lift, because without access to an upper floor, the impact on people with disabilities (who can not meet a requirements to use steps or stairways) will likely result in lost opportunities to:
