To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the House of Representatives; This petition of 'certain citizens and residents of Australia', draws to the attention of the House the Urgent need for a "Judicial Misbehaviour Committee" due to the obligation for such a Committee created by s.72(ii) of the Constitution and the conflict of interest/cronyism s.75(v) of the Constitution imposes on certain Commonwealth Public Officials when the wrongs of their Family and High Court Brethren are sought to be corrected by <u>s.75(v) Writ, treated as if it is</u> Common Law.
