- ❑ The Senate ordered the Minister for Industry, Science and Resources to table any documents, including (but not limited to) internal memos, internal reports, consultants' reports, tender documentation, tender submissions or appendices to tender submissions, held by the Australian Nuclear Science and Technology Organisation relating to fuel for the new nuclear reactor at Lucas Heights (no later than 4pm on 26 June 2000)
