## **Education, Employment and Workplace Relations Legislation Committee**

The committee called the:

Among other issues, the following issues were discussed:

- the rationale for the name change of Fair Work Australia to the Fair Work Commission and the associated costs involved
- the division of time for the President of the Fair Work Commission between duties at the Commission and the Federal Court
- activities of the Fair Work Ombudsman in relation to compliance in the hospitality industry
- staffing levels at Safe Work Australia
- annual spending on research concerning safety regulations for the use of motor vehicles by children under the age of sixteen
- the role of the Director of the Fair Work Building Industry Inspectorate in comparison with the previous role within the former Australian Building and Construction Commission
- the appropriateness of public statements of the Director of the Fair Work Building Inspectorate in defence of the agency
- employment services
- flexible working arrangements
- protections for paternal leave and pregnant workers.
