6 The Parliament of Australia enacts:

7 **1 Short title**

8 This Act may be cited as the *Carbon Credits (Consequential*
9 *Amendments) Act 2011*.

10 **2 Commencement**

- 11 (1) Each provision of this Act specified in column 1 of the table
12 commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with

1 column 2 of the table. Any other statement in column 2 has effect
2 according to its terms.

1 **Part 2—Transitional provisions**

2 **17 Transitional—Registry accounts**

3 **Scope**

- 4 (1) This item applies to an account held by a person within the register:
- 5 (a) known as the Australian National Registry of Emissions
6 Units; and
- 7 (b) that was in existence under the executive power of the
8 Commonwealth immediately before the commencement of
9 this item.

10 **Continuation of account**

- 11 (2) The account continues in existence as a Registry account under the
12 *Australian National Registry of Emissions Units Act 2011*.

13 **18 Transitional—Commonwealth Registry accounts**

14 **Scope**

- 15 (1) This item applies to an account held by the Commonwealth within the
16 register:
- 17 (a) known as the Australian National Registry of Emissions
18 Units; and
- 19 (b) that was in existence under the executive power of the
20 Commonwealth immediately before the commencement of
21 this item.

22 **Designation of account**

- 23 (2) If, immediately before the commencement of this item, the account was
24 described as a Commonwealth holding account, the *Australian National*
25 *Registry of Emissions Units Act 2011* has effect as if the account had
26 been designated by the Carbon Credits Administrator as a
27 Commonwealth holding account.
- 28 (3) If, immediately before the commencement of this item, the account was
29 described as the retirement account for the first commitment period, the
30 *Australian National Registry of Emissions Units Act 2011* has effect as
31 if the account had been designated by the Carbon Credits Administrator
32 as the retirement account for the first commitment period.

Schedule 1 General amendments

Part 2 Transitional provisions

- 1 (4) If, immediately before the commencement of this item, the account was
2 described as the net source cancellation account for the first
3 commitment period, the *Australian National Registry of Emissions*
4 *Units Act 2011* has effect as if the account had been designated by the
5 Carbon Credits Administrator as the net source cancellation account for
6 the first commitment period.
 - 7 (5) If, immediately before the commencement of this item, a
8 Commonwealth Registry account was described as the non-compliance
9 cancellation account for the first commitment period, the *Australian*
10 *National Registry of Emissions Units Act 2011* has effect as if the
11 account had been designated by the Carbon Credits Administrator as the
12 non-compliance cancellation account for the first commitment period.
 - 13 (6) If, immediately before the commencement of this item, the account was
14 described as the voluntary cancellation account for the first commitment
15 period, the *Australian National Registry of Emissions Units Act 2011*
16 has effect as if the account had been designated by the Carbon Credits
17 Administrator as the voluntary cancellation account for the first
18 commitment period.
 - 19 (7) If, immediately before the commencement of this item, the account was
20 described as the mandatory cancellation account for the first
21 commitment period, the *Australian National Registry of Emissions*
22 *Units Act 2011* has effect as if the account had been designated by the
23 Carbon Credits Administrator as the mandatory cancellation account for
24 the first commitment period.
 - 25 (8) If, immediately before the commencement of this item, a
26 Commonwealth Registry account was described as the temporary
27 certified emission reduction replacement (expiry) account for the first
28 commitment period, the *Australian National Registry of Emissions*
29 *Units Act 2011* has effect as if the account had been designated by the
30 Carbon Credits Administrator as the temporary certified emission
31 reduction replacement (expiry) account for the first commitment period.
 - 32 (9) If, immediately before the commencement of this item, the account was
33 described as the long-term certified emission reduction replacement
34 (expiry) account for the first commitment period, the *Australian*
35 *National Registry of Emissions Units Act 2011* has effect as if the
36 account had been designated by the Carbon Credits Administrator as the
37 long-term certified emission reduction replacement (expiry) account for
38 the first commitment period.

- 1 (10) If, immediately before the commencement of this item, the account was
2 described as the long-term certified emission reduction replacement
3 (storage reversal) account for the first commitment period, the
4 *Australian National Registry of Emissions Units Act 2011* has effect as
5 if the account had been designated by the Carbon Credits Administrator
6 as the long-term certified emission reduction replacement (storage
7 reversal) account for the first commitment period.
- 8 (11) If, immediately before the commencement of this item, the account was
9 described as the long-term certified emission reduction replacement
10 (non-certification) account for the first commitment period, the
11 *Australian National Registry of Emissions Units Act 2011* has effect as
12 if the account had been designated by the Carbon Credits Administrator
13 as the long-term certified emission reduction replacement
14 (non-certification) account for the first commitment period.

15 **19 Transitional—section 75 of the *National Greenhouse and***
16 ***Energy Reporting Act 2007***

- 17 (1) This item applies to a determination if:
- 18 (a) the determination was made for the purpose of section 75 of
19 the *National Greenhouse and Energy Reporting Act 2007*;
20 and
- 21 (b) the determination was in force immediately before the
22 commencement of this item.
- 23 (2) The determination has effect, after the commencement of this item, as if
24 it had been made under section 75 of the *National Greenhouse and*
25 *Energy Reporting Act 2007* as amended by this Act.
