# Public hearings in Queensland for inquiry into teacher education

The House Education Committee will begin a three day program in Queensland as part of its inquiry into teacher education tomorrow with a visit to the Central Queensland University (CQU) at Noosa. The focus of the visit will be CQU's Bachelor of Learning Management (BLM) program.

"Many of the submissions that we have received in this inquiry point to the need for stronger partnerships between teacher education institutions, education authorities and schools in developing and delivering teacher education. We are interested in looking at the partnership model operating in CQU's BLM," said Committee Chair Mr Luke Hartsuyker MP.

The Committee will hear from a number of other universities during public hearings in Brisbane on Wednesday 6 July and Thursday 7 July. Also appearing will be the Queensland Government and the Queensland Board of Teacher Registration.
