## Adelaide public hearings for teacher education inquiry

The House Education Committee will hear the views of Flinders University and the University of South Australia as part of its inquiry into teacher education next Tuesday (27 September) and Wednesday (28 September).

"Many of the submissions that we have received in this inquiry point to the need for stronger partnerships between universities, education authorities and schools in developing and delivering teacher education," said Committee Chair Mr Luke Hartsuyker MP.

The Committee will also hear from other universities, organisations and authorities during the public hearings in Adelaide from 27 to 29 September. Among those appearing will be the South Australian Government, the Teachers Registration Board of South Australia, the Australian Association of Mathematics Teachers and the Rural Education Forum Australia.
