Inquiry into Teacher Education

Perth public hearings for teacher education inquiry

Five Western Australian universities involved in teacher education will have the opportunity to put forward their views about how well teachers are being prepared for the classroom when they appear before a parliamentary committee in Perth next Tuesday (25 October) and Wednesday (26 October).

The House Education Committee is conducting a major inquiry into teacher education.

"We are interested in learning about the ways in which the universities link theory and practice," said Committee Chair Mr Luke Hartsuyker MP. Many of the submissions that we have received express strong concern about the quality of the practicum component of teacher education courses."

"Another emerging focus of the inquiry is partnerships," said Mr Hartsuyker. "We are interested to know about effective partnerships that exist in Western Australia between universities, employing authorities and schools. We would also like to hear about any impediments to building stronger partnerships."

As well as hearing from the universities and current teacher education students, the Committee will also hear from other organisations and authorities during the public hearings in Perth. Among those appearing will be the Western Australian Government, the Western Australian College of Teaching, the Association of Principals of Catholic Secondary Schools in Australia and the Western Australian Council of State School Organisations.
