Obesity hearing in Mackay

Committee to also inspect Mater Misericordiae Hospital

The House of Representatives Health Committee will hear from some of Mackay's community health experts on obesity when it holds a public hearing in Mackay on Monday 18 August 2008 for the federal parliamentary inquiry into obesity in Australia.

The committee chaired by Steve Georganas (Member for Hindmarsh, SA), will hear about local projects and initiatives from Mackay City Council, the Tropical Population Health Network of Queensland Health, the City Fitness Gym and Dr Rachel Bidgood a local general practitioner. The Committee is particularly interested in community fitness events and projects aimed at getting the community to be active.

The Active Parks project is an exciting initiative by the Mackay Regional Council that the committee is keen to learn more about and which could be adopted in other states said Mr Georganas. Members are also interested to learn how local health centres such as the City Fitness Gym can encourage people to get regular exercise he said. The committee also wants to see how state governments can help support active communities by encouraging pedestrian friendly environments, walking and bicycling tracks, Active Parks program and the 10,000 steps program.

The committee will visit the Mater Misericordiae Hospital in Mackay before the hearing to see the facilities used to educate people about diet and diabetes management.
