## **Obesity hearing in Perth**

## Committee to also visit the West Leederville Community Gardens

The House of Representatives Health Committee will travel to Western Australia this week to hear from leading community health experts on obesity when it holds a public hearing in Perth on Thursday 6 November 2008 for the federal parliamentary inquiry into obesity in Australia.

The committee chaired by Steve Georganas (Member for Hindmarsh, SA), will hear from the Western Australian Department of Health; the Public Health Association of Australia and the Public Health Advocacy Institute; the Telethon Institute for Child Health; Kalgoorlie-based paediatrician and clinical coordinator of the Northern Goldfields Kidney Health Project, Dr Christine Jeffries Stokes; the Cancer Council WA; and Slow Food Perth. The committee is interested to learn how the experiences of these organisations can be applied to the wider Australian context.

The committee will also visit a thriving communal community garden in West Leederville.
