First hearing for Overseas Trained Doctors Inquiry to be held in Canberra

The House of Representatives Standing Committee on Health and Ageing will hold a public hearing on Friday 25 February 2011 to discuss the registration processes and support available for Overseas Trained Doctors (OTD's) seeking full Australian registration.

Committee Chair **Mr Steve Georganas, MP** said: "Overseas trained doctors form an integral part of Australia's medical workforce. This inquiry will assist those overseas trained doctors, both currently in Australia and overseas, to better navigate the path to full Australian qualifications, which to date has been a long and difficult process."

- 12.15 pm **Royal Australasian College of Physicians**, is an independent organisation responsible for training, educating and representing physicians and paediatricians in Australia and New Zealand.
