Overseas Trained Doctors Inquiry moves to Brisbane

The House of Representatives Standing Committee on Health and Ageing will hold a public hearing in Brisbane on Thursday 10 March to discuss the registration processes and support available for Overseas Trained Doctors (OTD's) seeking full Australian recognition.

Committee Chair **Mr Steve Georganas, MP** said: "The Committee has already taken evidence which points to a range of issues faced by medical practitioners in achieving registration and accreditation of their overseas qualifications. In particular the inconsistent range of requirements imposed by different Government, regulatory and professional organisations has been emphasised."
