Inquiry into recent Australian
 bushfires

To the Select Committee on the Recent Australian bushfires

This is a pro forma submission made to you with respect to the above mentioned matter. I apologize for not making a more detailed submission but find in the current circumstances that I have little choice to do otherwise. That is; despite; the constitutionally implied and otherwise established rights of the individual to the freedoms of communication about matters political, and, association; and; the, statutorily prescribed, and customary common law requirements, for the principle and objective of ecologically sustainable development (ESD) to be adhered to; the Commonwealth Government of Australia, and various associates thereof [including, so-called private job network page 1 (P.T.O.)]

member organisations, the 'Eling' which unlawfully goes under the protected name "Centrolim", community based associations and even the Queensland Police Service, have utilized State and Federal government funds to develop systems that achieve no real purposes of any worthy merit, but are, deliberately or through sheer incompetence (or more likely a mixture of both), designed to frustrate and annoy the under resourced and under privileged with gross abuses of their state based rights and privileges, and basic human rights they are entitled to as Australian citizens (or indeed global citizens - eg. overseas visitors entitled to receive welfare assistance when visiting Australia).

The abhorrent practices to which I refer include unlawful involuntary coercive treatment and unlawful discrimination made against individuals, such as myself, on the basis of their political activity or; political convictions, opinions or beliefs.

For example, the above mentioned 'thing', which has no real power or authority to act as a delegate of the Secretary of the Department of Social Security and thereby make decisions pursuant to the social security laws, has been permitted by the government to, unlawfully access government information, and utilize vast amounts of government resources for the purposes of, attempting to impersonate government officers, misinterpretation and subsequent ultra vires misapplication of the social security laws. In doing so, the 'thing' has unlawfully deprived some individuals of the page 2

the social security law and the best legal advice available, resulting in being obliged to wait in an office for hours (say 3-4 hrs) until said 'federal magistrate' has been substituted, only to then, subsequently, have opportunity to adequately participate in public health related opportunities for our public participants in the decision making processes of government bodies, thereby potentially jeopardizing a very promising self-giving condition.

Decisions being of very limited time and resources with which to reasonably contribute recommendations with respect to your matter, namely because the circumstances referred to above are urgent matters, I make the following general submissions and strongly recommend your government - including parliament, to immediately, in light of the matter mentioned above, make arrangements to have your recommendations implemented (or the previous administrative changes) - for the prompt and effective implementation of those recommendations.

 2. Project a request for local representation. I shall however, if possible, represent the relevant stakeholder interests in person.
 3. An initial report of the relevant stakeholder interests and their activities in respect of any proposed developments is to be made available to the relevant stakeholders. I shall, however, be a member of any relevant committee. I shall, however, not be associated with local, regional or national committees, and particularly my right to withdraw any particular stakeholder from this attention, in to add to it in any way or manner, as we are accustomed.

Please respond to this submission by end of day Friday 20th January 2003. Your response and your understanding of my request of this letter, acknowledging the same, will be greatly appreciated. Thank you for your consideration.
