We feel that these Parks should be managed and regulated in the same way as other public lands including catchments, reserves, wilderness ect, encouraging salvage of storm and fire damaged stands of Mountain and Alpine Ash, and thinning as a fuel reduction tool

Fuel reduction burning with cook fires at the appropriate time and season is considered to be the best and most economic and best management practice advised to me by sixth generation settlers in this area.
