Planning Institute of Australia to discuss coastal zone planning

The House of Representatives Climate Change, Water, Environment and the Arts Committee will hear from the Planning Institute of Australia at a public hearing in Canberra on 13 November 2008 as part of its inquiry into climate change and environmental impacts on Australia's coastal zone.

"PIA is the national peak body for planners, representing some 5,000 planning professionals across Commonwealth, state and local government, and the private sector", Committee Chair Ms George said.

"Planners, along with architects and engineers, have crucial roles to play in building Australia's ability to adapt to a changing climate. Early planning for the impacts of climate change, and appropriate adaptation strategies that reduce the vulnerability of natural ecosystems and infrastructure to these impacts, are likely to bring considerable cost advantages."

"The Committee looks forward to hearing PIA's views on these matters," Ms George said.

The inquiry will examine existing policies and programs related to coastal zone management, ways to promote sustainable use of coastal resources, and strategies for climate change adaptation. The Committee is also looking at ways to promote sustainable coastal communities, as well as governance and institutional arrangements for Australia's coastal zone.
