I and my family are concerned of the Governments attitude to the ABC,s Regional funding for its services, and would like to convey the following,

- 1. Funding of ABC,s rural services should not be cut, but increased as my family has witnessed the services decrease over the last 20 years.
- 2. The ABC is the only medium that I as a parent can allow our children to use, as commercial services are not of an appropriate nature or environment for children.
- 3. The ABC,s funding for better coverage in rural areas should be increased:
 - A. As most areas have poor quality reception. on AM and FM.
 - B. Most regional houses are insulated and have sisilation, which cuts down reception in the house or building.
 - C. Country or regional people need 15mtr (50ft) or better towers and specific antennas to receive a noise free ABC reception. (Ie. clock radios, mantle radios, stereo systems, VCR's, TV's, etc.)
 - D. At present country people pay \$900.00 \$2500.00 including the G.S.T. to have a noise free ABC reception, when our city cousins pay very little.
 - E. The ABC needs to transmit all services in stereo and not Mono or L+R (left plus right channel), as most equipment purchased today is full stereo.

In closing I urge your committee to increase funding to the ABC for regional services.
