APPENDIX I: CONDUCT OF THE INQUIRY

Terms of reference

On 1 September 1997 the then Commonwealth Minister for Employment, Education, Training and Youth Affairs, Senator Amanda Vanstone, wrote to the then Chairman of the Committee, Mr Bob Charles, MP, requesting the Committee to inquire into and report on the appropriate roles of institutes of technical and further education and the extent to which those roles should overlap with universities.

Advertising the inquiry

The inquiry was advertised nationally in *The Australian* on Wednesday 24 September 1997 and *Campus Review*, 1-7 October 1997. The Committee wrote to State and Territory Premiers and Chief Ministers and to over 350 TAFE institutes, universities, chambers of commerce, academic and research bodies, education unions, and student organisations.

Evidence to the inquiry

The Committee received 109 submissions from 99 parties. These submissions are listed at Appendix II.

The Committee received 53 exhibits to the inquiry which were provided as attachments to written submissions or offered to the Committee at public hearings. These are listed at Appendix III.

Public hearings and inspections

The Committee held eleven public hearings in: Perth, Adelaide, Melbourne, Canberra, Sydney and Brisbane. This involved 92 witnesses in total. Details of the hearings and witnesses who appeared are at Appendix IV.

The Committee completed two inspections: in Perth at the Western Australian Academy of Performing Arts; and in Adelaide at Regency Institute of TAFE.

Transcript of evidence

At the public hearings 722 pages of evidence were recorded by *Hansard*. The transcript of evidence taken at public hearings, and copies of all written submissions, will be made available for inspection at the Committee Office of the House of Representatives and at the National Library of Australia.
