WESLEY MISSION TO APPEAR AT SYDNEY PUBLIC HEARING

The House of Representatives Standing Committee on Education and Employment will hear from representatives of Wesley Mission at a public hearing in Sydney on Friday 17 June. Wesley Mission supports people with mental ill-health from across NSW to access employment through a range of services. As well as assisting consumers in metropolitan Sydney, it has a strong focus on regional areas.

The Committee will also take evidence from representatives of Black Dog Institute, Multicultural Mental Health Australia, Transcultural Mental Health, Macquarie University – Campus Wellbeing, Carers NSW and NSW Consumer Advisory Group – Mental Health Inc.

The Committee's Chair, Ms Amanda Rishworth, said "the Committee is looking forward to hearing from a diverse range of witnesses doing important work across NSW. We will hear from organisations advocating on behalf of some of the most marginalised members of our society who are living with mental illness, including the homeless, those from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds and young people."
