The House of Representatives Standing Committee on Education and Employment will tomorrow hear from a number of key government stakeholders as well as employer associations, including the ACCI, for its inquiry into mental health and workforce participation.

The Committee's Chair, Ms Amanda Rishworth said, "government organisations and employer groups both have key roles to play in this space and we look forwards to comprehensive discussions tomorrow on strategies to enhance access to and participation in education, training and employment for those with a mental illness, as well as ways to promote mental wellbeing more generally in all workplaces."
