## Second public hearing for TAFES inquiry

The House Standing Committee on Education and Employment will hold its second public hearing for the TAFES inquiry in Brisbane this Friday.

The Committee will hear from key stakeholders, including TAFE Directors Australia, and hold roundtable discussions with employer, industry and skills associations, community organisations and unions.

The Chair, Mr Mike Symon MP, said, 'The TAFE system is the backbone of the Australia workforce, having provided training and skills development to Australians for more than 100 years. A strong, highly accessible TAFE system is necessary to address current skills shortages and fortify the Australian workforce now and into the future.'
