House Economics Committee to discuss Australia's high-tech manufacturing sector

Representatives from the Australian Electrical and Electronic Manufacturers' Association Limited (AEEMA) will appear before the House of Representatives Economics Committee in Canberra today for the inquiry into the state of Australia's manufactured export and import competing base, now and beyond the resources boom.

AEEMA is the peak national industry body for infrastructure providers for Australia's information and communication technology, electronics, and electrical manufacturing industries. Their submission to the inquiry discusses the need for Australia to master 'product realisation'–all the tasks and activities required to convert a business concept into an industrially relevant and customer focussed product. This includes robust prototyping activity.
