This submission is in response to the JSCEM's invitation for public comment as part of its Inquiry into the Conduct of the 2001 Federal Election.

I believe that the current voting arrangments for Australian citizens overseas - that unless you register yourself as an overseas voter you will not be sent a postal ballot for any relevant election - are unreasonable.

I in fact was not able to vote in the last Federal election, as I had not realised that completion of an application for a postal vote was not sufficient for a postal ballot to be sent to me in the UK. I completed such a form, & sent it in, then wondered why I didn't receive a postal ballot. I contacted the AEC by email, & they very politely responded to my query about my 'missing' ballot paper, & whether or not I would therefore be fined for not voting in the election. On their advice, I wrote a letter to the AEC explaining why I had not voted.

Just after doing this, I was exploring the AEC website to find out electoral results in seats of interest, & discovered that unless I completed an additional form, applying for registration as an overseas elector, I would not be/have been sent a postal ballot, despite completing the other form. This astonished me!

I emailed the AEC again to explain what had happened and to ask them to ignore my latest email/letter. They very sweetly did not take offence at my wasting their time! I then sent off this latest form, & hope it's been received!

If I, with a PhD, can't manage to work out how to vote in the Australian Federal Election, what hope has the average Aussie overseas?

Thank you for taking the time to read this submission, and I hope to see some positive outcomes as a result of this Inquiry.
