DEFENCE SUBMISSION TO THE JOINT STANDING COMMITTEE ON ELECTORAL MATTERS (JSCEM) INTO THE 2007 FEDERAL ELECTION

1. Thank you for your invitation to make a submission regarding the trial of remote electronic voting for ADF personnel deployed overseas for the 2007 Federal Election as part of the inquiry by JSCEM into the 2007 Federal Election.

2. Defence in conjunction with the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC), being the lead agency for the trial, conducted the first ever trial of remote electronic voting for ADF overseas deployed personnel for the 2007 Federal Election.

3. The trial was evaluated, and a report jointly prepared by the AEC and Defence. The report comprehensively details the conduct and outcomes of the remote electronic voting trial, and is currently listed as Exhibit 169.2 to Submission 169: <u>Remote Electronic Voting at the 2007 Federal Election for Overseas Australian Defence Force Personnel</u>.

4. A copy of the joint report is attached, and comprises Defence's input to JSCEM on the 2007 Federal Election.
