Western Australia and as far afield as one call from New Zealand. I have also had many calls from Father's not being able to see their own children. I strongly urge the Government to look closely at the laws to overcome this unfair method the Family Court uses to decide who the children spend time with.

(1) I feel that both parents should have shared parenting as rule and the difficult cases sorted out by the Family Courts.

(2) Grandparents should be included in any contact arrangements. The best interest of the child being paramount in all cases.
