Dear Committee Members.

Please find attached a submission sent on the 6th August 2003. Upon re- reading our submission we envisage that the members of the committee may not appreciate the range of organisations that are represented in the Family Law Foundation. We considered that it would be useful for members of the committee to be aware of the great scope of organisations involved.

The Family Law Foundation commenced in 2002, following concerns about the myths and misunderstanding in the community about Family law matters. Subsequently, the heads of the three major family law mediation providers invited potentially interested organisations to attend a meeting to discuss their concerns. Almost everyone invited attended. The list of organisations who attended this meeting is attached.

At this initial meeting, the Chief Justice of Western Australian the Honourable David Malcolm accepted an invitation to open proceedings by addressing the gathering. The outcome of the meeting was a unanimous mandate from those represented, to form the Family Law Foundation. Also attached, is a copy of the Foundation's 'Aims and Philosophy'.

The Commonwealth Attorney General's Department has advised that it views the Foundation as being a model for similar organisations in other parts of Australia to improved community understanding on family law issues. The Attorney General provided us with an \$10,000 seed grant to assist the Foundation in carrying out its objectives.

## PHILOSOPHY

# The need for balance in community discussion of family law issues and a focus on the rights of the child.

## AIMS

- To ensure community access to accurate information about the wide range of solutions available to resolve difficulties arising from the breakdown of family relationships.
- To assist in the development of a long-term community education campaign regarding the family law system and, promote discussion about the principles that underpin the family law system.
- To ensure that the protection and wellbeing of children informs all discussions.
- To ensure that the impact of family and domestic violence is recognised and considered in discussions.
- To promote a safe environment for individuals and institutions involved in the family law system.
- To promote informed debate about family law issues.

#### STRATEGIES

- o Collect and disseminate to parliamentarians, media and others, such research data, articles and judgements as will;
  - ensure an appreciation of the extent to which most relationship issues are now resolved by mediation/conciliation/counselling/lawyer facilitated negotiation, and the extent to which the court system is reserved for the most complex and difficult cases;
  - > address misunderstandings prevalent in the community about family law issues.
- Encourage media to publish material that promotes the peaceful and co-operative resolution of relationship issues;
- Encourage media to avoid publication of material that condones violence, whether against members of the family or those who seek to protect their interests;
- Stimulate discussion about the impact of the family law system and the behaviour of parents and guardians in the context of the system and the consequences of such behaviour;
- O Lobby to give effect to the aims of the Foundation.
