RE : Child Access Forum.

Dear Ken,

I'am unable to attend the forum this evening but would like to offer the following points for a submission.

- 1) I'am a divorced father of 2 children aged 10 & 14. I separated 3&1/2 years ago & have always paid child support
- 2) My former wife came out of the property settlement with a 100 acre property with house, enough cash to buy another modern, 4 bed brick home, a car & everything in the family home( furniture etc). My former wife is debt free, owns her new home, has 2 cars ( 1 brand new \$20,000 toyota), has a job & has a reasonable lifestyle.
- 3) I'am in favour of, & have always wanted to support my children.
- The amount of child support I pay far exceeds what it actually costs.
  - a) The child support formula, obviously, does not take into account a custodial parent getting a substantial property settlement. (enough to re-establish themselves with a modern home debt free.)
  - b) My calculations add up to \$60 per week, per child, if housing them was taken care of in the property settlement.
  - c) These calculations are accurate & based on experience. (14 years as a parent, 11 of which before separation.)
    d) Both parents should be sharing the costs of the kids equally. (ie, 2 kids = \$60 per parent per week.)

e) I pay \$200 per week + 60% of any extra "special needs".

5) I have to re- establish with no possibility of a home lone (Banks will not lend money to paying parents of child support who are paying 27% of their income.)

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- 6) The Child support Agency does not administer how the child support is spent. (My former wife uses the money for other things including her own, and her mothers lifestyle. She also refuses to buy medicines for my children that exceed \$20 \* because they are too dear".) My former wife does not have private health insurance because she knows I will have to pay 60% of any important health issues with the children anyway.
- 7) I still have to pay child support to my former wife when I have the children. I have access every second weekend & half of school holidays mid year & 2 weeks at Christmas. While the children are in my care & I pay for them & also have to pay my former wife. (Whilst struggling to provide a reasonable holiday for the kids at christmas ,in addition, I have to pay \$400 to her.)
- 8) <u>THIS SYSTEM DOES NOT WORK</u> It causes nothing but heartache for the good, responsible fathers that are genuine. It distances these fathers from their kids. It motivates paying parents to find ways to avoid paying, & is very <u>lucrative</u> for the custodial parent, particularly if former partner (paying parent) was a good provider.
