8 as my previous correspondence has surely indicated to you I am incensed at the clearly incorrect and biased way I have been dealt with by the C\$A.

I enclose some recent correspondence between the C\$A and myself. You will note that the documentation says I own a property freehold, unfortunately the C\$A have previously sent me the mortgage documents for the property. Are they lying or stupid?

The amount that I have had extorted out of me (I consider it no better than demanding money with menaces) seems to not be based on the number of children that I am paving for nor does it seem to be based at all on my income.
