The stress of getting equipment is the thing that stresses me out as a carer the most. Thank goodness there is funding for all of the equipment that my daughter requires. I have to reapply for funding every 12 months. Duplicating that should already be in her file & Dr Certificates to be re done.

has had Cerebral palsy which is a disability for life.

drives a power chair \$10,000 paid for by the Canberra lions club.,

A manual chair \$7,500, paid by the Canberra hospital system, Community options, Community Connections & Carers ACT & us. (Chairs are so expensive because can't sit up by her self, so she needs a seating system.)

Foot orthotics on both legs \$1000 each, from Westmead hospital.

Standing frame \$ 3.500, borrowed from Therapy ACT.

A lifter, \$3000 from Carers ACT.

Shower chair/ Commode \$3,000 from Carers ACT.

A van & adoptions to transport a power chair, \$60,000 us.

Ramping the front & back of our house & converting a bathroom. \$150,000, us.

Please note these prices are all approximates.

What I need is a single organisation in each state that coordinates all the government monies. One place that I and/or Occupational Therapist, can apply to for funding. This organisation needs to understand what is an appropriate amount of money for the type of disability that has. Also what type of equipment needs that she will have over her life time.

can't sit, stand or walk. She goes to main stream school with her brother & sister. She is keeping up educationally with her peers. She has good communication skills. Due to the amount of, distance to, & timing of scheduled appointments for doctors, specialist, Therapists, and education specialists. Not to mention the cost & co-ordination of after school care & school holiday programs. I work casually as a hairdresser. My husband works in the public service. We have no family support as a back up. This gives you some background about me.
