As a carer, I feel that my role is...

- undervalued & unappreciated by health professionals & the general community
- necessary for my children's well being
- too difficult to sustain
- advocate, counsellor, financial prep, problem-solver

2. The barriers to social and economic participation for carers

As a carer, I face the following problems ...

- Single parent so often no support for me.
- Work full time so workshops etc not available - too tired to go out at night.
- Have to make phone calls etc in work hours to doctors, agencies etc.
- No financial security, fears for future.
- During crises, can't be there or often no help available
- VERY DIFFICULT TO ACCESS HELP WHEN NEEDED.

As a carer, I need help with ...

Reliable backup agencies to step in & fill the gap.

Financial help to loved ones who often can't afford medications & basics -

After hours care - people don't only get sick 9-5 Mon-Fri.

Care for me - if I break down, so do my kids

Acknowledging & valuing the work we do including saving
gov. money.

Provide more real assistance for our loved ones - just
