As a carer, I feel that my role is...

To try & make my son more independent as he is 26 years old.
To try & encourage him not to give up & if he continues taking his medication everything will improve. Trouble is when they feel great, often they think they no longer need it. To be there when they need us & to support them.

2. The barriers to social and economic participation for carers

As a carer, I face the following problems ...

Centrelink have no idea what a struggle it is to get your young person to hand forms in. Often they forget & are straight away cut off. I'm supporting my son financially as he has no job or centrelink. Centrelink keep requesting more documentation & so usually give up. Mental impaired people cannot handle More information is attached on a separate sheet so much stress & so give up. People in general have no idea living with somebody with a mental illness how it destroys

3. The practical measures required to better support carers

As a carer, I need help with ...

Special cheaper accomodation. Currently paying \$700 per month to stay at uni accomodation but only temporaly as my son deferred from his course. Need more workshops -

special jobs that these people can cope with. more support from centrelink, doctors. When parents ring for emergency

help should be given straight More information is attached on a separate sheet away & not during a working week. Carers are not counted for

4. Strategies to assist carers to access opportunities and choices all the work we

I think the Government can better help carers by ... do to support our young ones.

Providing more care (housing) as these people can maybe work part-time but not fulltime.

They need help in budgeting as with bipolar during a manic episode they can spend their money in one go.

Education (media) To be more compassionate & not judge so hastily. Helping More information is attached on a separate sheet

other family members to come to terms with somebody

else & how to help the mentally impaired cope in family life.
