I am the parent/carer of an Asperger's (Autism) son (17).
There is a great gap in any assistance for the Aspergers in our community. The care is left solely to the parents with only negligible respite or support.

As a carer, I feel that my role is... to provide the additional support & guidance for my son. Both for & to my son but equally to the education system & community to help all of us live together. Aspergs do not have an Intellectual Disability & so have to live in our world. There is no assistance to help them & us, as carers.

A lack of opportunity to socialise due to lack of respite care & an unwillingness to try due to no opportunity to meet other parents who understand our issues.

- Organise a social outing organised with other parents
- Social outings for my son in an environment that is not crowded & with intellectual & physical disabilities;
- Support group situations, run by specialist

I think the Government can better help carers by ...

- Funding given to the groups, i.e. Caroline, etc. who have direct contact with us & to enable them to set-up social settings to socialise
- New Autism funding specifically for Aspergers kids to create an environment to socialise specifically for teens & young adults.
