

my boy takes up a lot of time & energy. As  
much as you try & be  
all things to all people it is just impossible.

As a carer, I need help with ...

money. I have not worked in the last 7 years and I would really like help to pay for my son's therapy bills which run from between one hundred & one hundred & sixty dollars a week during a year. Private health insurance

4. Strategies to assist carers to access opportunities and choices

I think the Government can better help carers by ...

- getting people in your departments to answer their phones & deal with your problems efficiently and with compassion for example I am still waiting to hear about a reconditioned computer for my son at school since my application in Sept. 2007.  
- more help with therapy bills either by working with the private insurers to get us more money back or by increasing carer payment direct to a therapist perhaps.
