I strongly feel that carers could cope better if we had more respite + the hope of residential care further down the track. I don't want to be a doddering pensioner looking after an adult disabled person.

Very undervalued. I believe that we save the government a terrific amount of money with little / poor support. We don't have the choices of previous generations. I think we are just expected to put up + shut up under enormous strains that most people wouldn't be able to cope with.
