I wish to make a submission to the House of Representatives Standing Committee on Family, Community Housing and Youth's Inquiry into Better Support for Carers.

My role as a carer is to support our son who suffers from a mental illness. My caring roll affects my life and my husband life by constantly monitoring taking of medication, personal hygiene on a daily bases, doctors

and dentist visits and the stress associated with living with a son with a mental illness.

I have been unable to obtain a carers allowance. As Roy and I age financial pressures will increase.

Roy is 60 and I am 57. We live on a small farm growing fresh vegetable to supplement Roy's Super Allocated Pension.

Mark has a Life style Support Package this has been a significant help to our family to have a support worker (buddy) arrive at our home and take Mark out of the "family surrounds" and into the wider community, one day a week for a few hours. Roy and I do a small amount of voluntary work in our community to have a "break" from our caring role.

Thank you for taking my views into consideration as part of the Committee's Inquiry. I look forward to reviewing the recommendations you make in order to improve support for carers.
