

I can't fully participate in social life because Because my Carers Role Demands THAT I BE THERE AT ALL TIMES, & ~~the~~ Most Transport & Venues ARE NOT DisAbLE friendly

I am financially struggling because of

THE Money the Government Pays to Carer's for FURNISH is only HALF of WHAT I EARNED in a week, THE Cost of Living & THE Cost of Nappies for my wife's in Continence (Although we get \$500 from P&P) Does not go far to Covering Costs. THE Amount of Money we Carers Save the Government By Keeping Them at Home or now they ARE cutting the over off Bonus per Year.

I would like to work (full time or part time) but have the following issues

I Cannot work part time due to the fact I am needed to do other things at home e.g. - washing, ironing, shopping, housework, lawns & garden. Plus looking after my wife - cleaning, dressing, bathing etc.

I worry about my future because -

The cost of living keeps going up; The carers becomes more demanding; But the government keeps saying the same.

The things that stress me the most about being a carer are Not knowing what lies ahead, financially or emotionally in caring for someone if something was to happen to me.

I think the government can better help carers by - giving them more financial & emotional support.
