To provide care 24 hours a day, physically & mentally. I had to give up all social activities. To be nurse, housekeeper & on duty regardless of my own health for many years

As a carer, I face the following problems ...

*High cost of equipment, medicines etc.
Lack of recreation for myself, always tired and very limited respite - especially of high care respite in country towns.
Loneliness when family not living near - isolated*

As a carer, I need help with ...

Petrol reimbursement when travel by public transport not suitable. Help with equipment cost, alterations to shower etc - easier accessibility to home where there are steps. Handyman access when male partner is invalid, home help to lighten household duties
