Just today, I have retuned yet again, from a third appointment in less than three months from visiting my Cardiologist in Murray Bridge. This too we must not lose.

So to that end, I am doing my best, to stress to others in the local area, how important that we all use these services provided. Otherwise we could be in danger of losing them. So I'm doing what I can to help support this very worthwhile local bus service. I fully realize that you are a very busy person. So I Thank you for your time, and interest in reading my letter and giving consideration to the enclosed important facts.
