As a carer, I face the following Problems, Living with my wife which has a severely affected balance problem. She has not driven a vehicle for years as her coordination of control has been effected also. To the extent of a walking frame. Also she has epilepsy.

As we live on a farm shopping and other appointments and activities with the children have always depended on me but she has a disabled taxi card this can be a help for appointments etc

As a carer, I need help with having people available to assist her with her shopping or appointments whether to meet her from the taxi or from other means if it is not possible for me to go. These services to my knowledge are not available for cases such as this. This can be arranged only for days which home help ladies help out. Her condition will deteriorate further.

As our son has chosen a farming career my time must also be spent with him for guidance etc.

Previous to our assets change on the family farm 12 months ago, she received a disabled pension from Centrelink, but now all pension benefits have ceased, which made it easier to meet her costs etc. because we are just above the cutoff point.

This is when they offered me the carers allowance.

As with the past drought, we have a drought relief allowance but this is a temporary fix.

I think the Government has let down carers and disabled people by not raising the assets cut off point as with land values, skyrocketing which makes for a low cut off point to qualify for the disabled pension.

I would suggest that the government bring in a graduated stepped assets test which would allow something for my wife even though we are just above the current cut off point.

With farming as you know assets will not make money with the drier seasons we have had.

The carer allowance is a help with which we are thankful for.

The cancellation of my wifes disabled pension was a very traumatic experience for her.

This explanation is a little off the purpose of the question but it also affects me as a carer.
